In collaboration with the organizers of the 4th International Multisensory Research Forum, there will be a special issue of Cognitive, Affective, & Behavioral Neuroscience dealing with research on sensory systems in which more than one modality plays a role. We seek to include work from a variety of scientific disciplines and perspectives (see www.imrf.info for a subset of example topics).

The special issue will include 2 or 3 theoretical/review articles (about 30,000 words), as well as a number of brief reports (3,000-4,000 words) and primary empirical articles (4,000+ words). Authors interested in submitting a theoretical review article should first submit a 2 page proposal to dshore@multisense.info by August 30, 2003. The deadline for brief reports and full size empirical papers, as well as completed review/theoretical papers is October 15, 2003.

Manuscript Submission: Two copies of a manuscript should be sent to David Shore, Department of Psychology, McMaster University, Hamilton, Ontario, Canada, L8S 4K1. In addition a PDF version of the manuscript, including table and figures, must be sent to dshore@multisense.info as an attachment. This PDF will be sent to the reviewers of the manuscript, so it must be complete. Also a message should be sent to the same email address listing the title, the authors, the abstract, and a list of 4 suggested reviewers.

Preparation of the manuscript should follow those specified for Psychonomic Society Publications (Psychonomic Bulletin & Review or Cognitive, Affective & Behavioral Neuroscience).
